**Closing Date: Friday, May 17, 2019**

Entries must be postmarked by this date. **NO EXCEPTIONS. No entries will be accepted after Friday, May 17, 2019.** Any changes of rider, horse, team or division after closing date will be assessed a \$10 change fee. **Entry Fees:** \$85 per competitor (Qualifying)  
\$75 per competitor (Non-Qualifying)  
Stable Managers are **FREE**

Entry fees and stabling fees may be paid with a club check payable to Tri-State Region or by PayPal. For those paying with PayPal there will be a handling fee of 2.6%.

**Late Entries: ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER FRIDAY, MAY 17, 2019, WILL BE CHARGED A LATE ENTRY FEE OF \$50.00.**

**Refunds:**

Refunds will be granted only with a doctor's or veterinarian's note, minus a \$10 administrative fee. Requests must be made by the DC or CA in writing and be accompanied by the doctor's or veterinarian's note. Requests should be sent to the secretary at the address listed above. Requests must be received by Thursday, June 6, 2019. Refunds will NOT be made the day of the rally.

### **Stabling:**

10' x 10' stalls with stall gates on grounds.  
Stalls are required for the day of the competition.  
\$25 stabling fee for Dressage Rally only (Club Check ONLY or PayPal) **Bedding not provided. Please bring your own.**  
Please be sure to indicate if you are doing both rallies.

***We will not be collecting Stall Deposit Checks. Clubs will be billed \$25 per competitor for any stalls left uncleaned.***

If you are arriving the night before the rally, please plan to overnight your horse according to USPC standards (refer to USPC Horse Management Handbook and Rules for Rallies 2019) You will be checked, but NOT judged until the grounds open on the day of the rally.

### **Tack Stalls:**

Tack Stalls will be assigned although they may not be located directly next to the team stabling.

### **Grounds:**

All rings are enclosed.

**Team Composition:** Teams will consist of 3 or 4 members without or without a Stable Manager. It is strongly advised that each team have a Stable Manager, This a club responsibility to provide the Stable Manager. Team members may be of mixed ratings and mixed riding levels. Each team must have a Chaperone. The Organizer will put together Scramble Teams, if needed. If there is a preference for scrambling, please notify the Organizer and note on the entries, although it cannot be guaranteed. *Note: jogs are required at all mounted rallies and all riders need to be sure they know the rules and their horses know how to jog.*

**NEW!!- JUNIOR AND SENIOR DIVISIONS:** Competitors in Junior Divisions is any member who is 17 years of age or under. Competitors in the Senior Divisions is any member that is 19 years of age or older. You may have teams that have both junior and senior members on them, however, any team with a mix of junior and senior member will be required to compete in the Senior Division and you must have permission from the parent of any junior member on a mixed-age team

**TESTS:** Each member will ride two tests, and may choose to do a musical ride. Competitors on Regular Team who wish to Qualify for USPC Championships **must do a musical ride at the same level as their tests**

### **Recommended Dressage Tests for 2019:.**

*(These are only recommendations. Competitor can ride any test their DC feels they are qualified to ride, higher or lower.) Please specify the Test you will be riding on the entry form.*

D1 - 2019 USDF Intro Test A and Intro Test B

D2 - 2019 USDF Intro Test B and Intro Test C

D3 - Training Level 1 and Training Level 2, or Beginner Novice A and B

C & Up - may choose from any test listed on this Omnibus or notify the Organizer and we will do our best to accommodate you.

Western Dressage Riders – riders may ride any 2017 WDAA Western Dressage tests. Western and English Dressage Riders may compete on the same team at our rally. However, they will be considered a separate discipline at a Championships.

**For those members who wish to Qualify to USPC Championships in Dressage**, they **must** follow the criteria stated in the 2019 Dressage Newsletter and therefore must ride from the following list for the level they are trying to qualify for: *NOTE: all riders must ride test 2 and 3 of their level and ride musical freestyle to qualify*

Training Level: 2019 USEF Training Level Test 2 and Test 3  
First Level & Up: 2019 USEF First Level Test 2 and Test 3 @ appropriate Level

**For those members who wish to Qualify to USPC Modified Championships**, they **must** follow the criteria stated in the 2019 Dressage Newsletter therefore must ride from the following list for the level they are trying to qualify for: *NOTE: all riders must ride test 1 & 2 to qualify*

Training Level: 2019 USEF Training Level Test 1 and Test 2  
First Level & Up: 2019 USEF First Level Test 1 and Test 2 @ appropriate Level

### **Written Test:**

Completing the written test will be required for all competitors. Test will be open-book and teams can work on them as a group, but each team member must turn in a completed test. On full teams (4 riders, 1 stable manager) the lowest score will be dropped.

### **Medical Cards and Armbands/Bracelets:**

Competitors must wear a Medical Armband with a completed Medical Card or a Medical Bracelet must be worn at all times while on the competition grounds.

### **Attire:**

Please refer to USPC Handbook and Rules for Dressage Competition – 2019- Article 36

**Sharing Mounts:** In order to provide a safe and enjoyable competition for our younger members; D-1's and D-2's ONLY may share mounts. PLEASE make note on the entry form.

### **Championships:**

**Please note on entry form if a competitor wishes to qualify for Championships and include completed Intent to Qualify Form with your entry packet.**

### **Coaching:**

Coaches are **required** and must be designated on Entry Form. **Note:**  
**Coaches cannot be chaperones.**

### **Volunteers:**

**Each club must provide 2 volunteers per team entered.** Please include the names and email addresses of your volunteers with each club entry. Job assignments will be assigned before the rally. If we do not have enough volunteers to fill the required jobs we cannot run the rally.

### **Tentative Schedule:**

Schedule to be determined after entries are received. Your DC or CA will be notified of the schedule at that time.

### **Meals:**

A concession stand will be available onsite.
